

Decisions of the Environment and Waste Management Overview and Scrutiny Committee held on Tuesday 24 July 2012

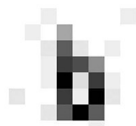

DECISIONS:

1. TRANSPORTATION AND RENDERING OF ANIMAL BY PRODUCTS

Resolved –

- (1) That the real concerns of local residents be acknowledged.
- (2) That the work of the Planning Service and the Environmental Health Service in dealing with the issues arising from this site and the transport of materials via the regulatory framework be noted.
- (3) That the Chief Executive writes to the relevant Government Minister highlighting the difficulties of regulating this industry as detailed in the letter to MPs, attached as Appendix 2 to Document “C”.
- (4) That the Chief Executive be requested to follow-up his letter of 26 April 2012, as outlined in Appendix 2, attached to Document “C”.
- (5) That the work of the officer partaking in the SNIFFER project to find solutions to the issues around odour control associated with this industry be supported.
- (6) That the appointment of a specialist consultant be supported and a progress report into his work be presented to this Committee in January 2013.
- (7) That the Executive be requested to consider the cost to the Council in relation to the regulation of the process and associated complaint investigation as part of the budget setting process for 2013-14.
- (8) That the Council’s Neighbourhood Service be requested to facilitate the setting-up of a liaison group with an agreed set of actions consisting of representatives of the local community, Council and Omega Proteins.



- (9) That the Council re-visit the out of hours single point of contact for dealing with residents complaints and enquiries.
